

THE 3905 (ANNUAL) ROUNDUP AWARD APPLICATION
(MIXED BANDS/MODES)

The 3905 Roundup (Annual) Award is earned by working a required number of contacts totaling **exactly** 3,905 points during any one-year period (or less) of the applicant's choosing.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. All applicants for this award must hold a 100-Point Certificate on at least one of the nets run by ***The 3905 Century Club, Inc.***
2. All contacts must be made on ***The 3905 Century Club, Inc.*** nets and may be on any mixture of bands and/or modes.
3. No contact made before May 1, 2006 may be used toward this award. All QSL cards applied toward this award may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
4. ***DO NOT*** enter any call sign more than once on this application.

NOTE: Any call sign modified by PORTABLE or MOBILE and/or a different state, province or DX entity is considered a different call sign for the purpose of this award. (See Definitions in the Bylaws, Article VI.)

5. All contacts applied toward this award must have been made within a one-year period of the applicant's choosing. For the purpose of this award, a year is defined as running from the beginning of the ZULU date on the first contact applied toward the award to the end of the ZULU day before that date in the following year.
6. Required contacts and their point values are: (remember, you need **exactly** 3,905 points)
 - a. SSB contacts with US states, no more than four (4) contacts with any one state – 20 points per contact, maximum of 3,000 points.
 - b. SSB contacts with DX entities, no more than ten (10) contacts, contacts may be with the same DX entity, 25 points per contact, maximum of 250 points.
 - c. CW/Digital contacts with any location, PSK/RTTY contacts 20 points, CW contacts 30 points, minimum of five (5) contacts using each of these three (3) modes for the balance of points required to total 3,905 points.

SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

1. After first assuring that each card used toward this award conforms to all of the requirements above, refer to the standard instructions contained in the application for the 100-Point Award, the SWL Award, or on our web site (Awards Program, General Information), or included with this application if it was obtained by postal mail, for submitting applications and paying awards/endorsement fees.
