

**THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC.**  
**THE REGINALD FESSENDEN AWARD APPLICATION**  
(EACH BAND/MODE SEPARATELY)

The Reginald Fessenden Award is earned for extensive operation by the applicant as a mobile or portable station within the country of Canada. Both the mobile and portable versions of this award may be earned separately for each band/mode combination for which **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** operates a net.

This award is named in honor of Reginald Aubrey Fessenden (1866-1932). A Canadian, Reginald Aubrey Fessenden was a noted inventor. A partial list of his inventions include a system for submarines to signal each other wirelessly under water, the fathometer (a sonar based depth detector), as well as being the first person to demonstrate that voices and music could be transmitted over the air without wires. His epitaph reads, "By his genius distant lands converse and men sail unafraid upon the deep."

**REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All applicants for this award must hold a 100-Point Certificate for the band/mode for which an application for this award is submitted.
2. All contacts must be made on **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** nets and must be on the same band and mode.
3. All QSL cards applied toward this award may have been used on prior awards and may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
4. The basic **Reginald Fessenden Award - Mobile** is a certificate earned for confirmed contacts with ten (10) different call signs made from each of a total of 9 Canadian provinces or territories in which the applicant was operating mobile.
5. The basic **Reginald Fessenden Award - Portable** is a certificate earned for confirmed contacts with ten (10) different call signs made from each of a total of 9 Canadian provinces or territories in which the applicant was operating portable.

**NOTE:** The applicant may work the same call sign from a different province/territory, but all call signs contacted while the applicant is operating from any one province or territory must be different. A call sign differing in prefix, call area, suffix, or modifier from another call sign is a different call sign, except that call signs differing by only a special prefix are not considered different.

**NOTE:** The applicant may not mix contacts made while mobile with contacts made while portable on any application for the Reginald Fessenden Award. Contacts made while mobile and contacts made while portable must be applied toward separate awards.

6. Endorsements to each of the basic 9-province/territory certificate awards listed above are available for additional contacts with ten (10) stations made from each of 11 provinces or territories, each of 12 provinces or territories, and each of 13 provinces or territories.
7. A plaque will be awarded free of charge to the applicant for achievement of the 13-province/territory level.
8. Stations achieving the 13-province/territory level will be officially identified on **The 3905 Century Club** nets as a "Snowrunner."

## **SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:**

1. After first assuring that each card used toward this award conforms to all of the requirements above, refer to the standard instructions contained in the application for the 100-Point Award, or on our web site (Awards Program, General Information), or included with this application if it was obtained by postal mail, for submitting applications and paying awards/endorsement fees.
