

**THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC.**  
**SWL AWARD APPLICATION**  
(EACH BAND/MODE SEPARATELY)  
(NOT ENDORSABLE)

The **SWL Award** is earned by submitting QSL cards confirming **monitored** contacts made between participants on nets run by **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** This award may be earned only once for each band/mode combination for which **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** operates an awards net.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

1. The requirements for this award are designed to allow SWL stations to participate in the awards program of **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** As shown on the application form, you may earn this award by confirming the **accurate monitoring of** a total of twenty (20) contacts made between 3905CC net participants at five (5) points for each contact confirmed for a total of 100 points.
2. There must be at least one confirmation from each of the ten United States Call Areas. The confirming QSL must confirm a QSO involving at least one station located in the indicated call area.
3. There may be no more than two confirmations from each net session. Please note that the date you fill in on the application must be the date shown on the confirming QSL card.
4. All confirmations must be for contacts made on **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** awards nets and must be on the same band and mode. You may apply for a separate award for each band and mode on which we operate awards nets.
5. **DO NOT** enter any call sign more than once on any one application.
6. All QSL cards applied toward this award may have been used on prior awards other than **The SWL Award**, and may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
7. **You may not submit a QSL for any contact in which you actively participated. All monitoring must be by way of received RF signals only.**
8. **This award may not be earned by any individual more than once on each band/mode combination on which The 3905 Century Club operates a net.**
9. Photocopies of QSL cards are acceptable when applying for this award and all other awards.
10. The 3905 Century Club provides a QSL bureau for the exchange of your cards. You are encouraged to use this service. If you do not use the bureau, please send your SWL-QSL, along with an SASE, directly to the station from whom you wish confirmation.
11. Earning the SWL 100-Point Certificate grants you an associate membership with no voting privileges. Regular voting membership is granted only to licensed amateurs.
12. If questions about the requirements for this award arise, please contact the Awards Committee whose decision will be final.

## SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

- 1. The following instructions for submitting awards applications are generic instructions intended to apply to all awards applications and some items mentioned, such as endorsements and plaques, may not apply to all awards. You must read each award document for the options applicable to that award. You will need to refer to either the Club web site or to the most recent 100-Point Award or SWL Award application to determine fees applicable to all other awards.**
2. Complete the application form. Check it carefully to assure that each card used conforms to all requirements above. Place your QSL cards in the order that you have them listed on the application form. **If you are using a single card for multiple contacts, attach a sticky note (or other obvious flag) to that card with a note that it has been used for multiple contacts so your Area Awards Manager can find the card easily when it is used later.** Make sure your correct mailing address, **and email address if you have one**, are on your application and that all information requested is complete and legible.
3. To submit your application, **enclose payment or proof of PayPal payment (see details below)**, your QSL cards or clear photocopies of same showing all needed information (see details below), a suitably sized **self-addressed** container with adequate postage for return of your QSL cards if you want them back, the completed application form, in a container suitable for the protection of your cards. Send all to the Area Awards Manager for the Call Area in which you live. Your QSL cards WILL NOT be returned unless YOU provide the required return **postage-paid, self-addressed** container. Names and addresses for our Area Awards Managers may be found on the Club website at <http://www.3905ccn.com/> or in the New Member Information document available on the web site or from our Information Officer by postal mail. Contact info for the Information Officer is in the officer listing on our web site and is also announced at the end of our nets.
- 4. Photocopies of QSL cards are acceptable toward ALL awards offered by The 3905CC. If needed information is on the back of a card, both front and back must be copied in a manner acceptable to your Area Awards Manager. Consult your Area Awards Manager directly if you have questions about his/her requirements for photocopied cards. Photocopied cards will be destroyed after the application is approved unless return postage is included.**
5. The postage for the return of your QSL cards must be applied to the return container, or enclosed separately. DO NOT combine with the awards fee. A separate check or money order made out to your Area Awards Manager, or postage stamps, are acceptable for return postage. Postage stamps are highly recommended because they make it much easier to return any excess postage.
6. The first 100-Point Award earned by a personal call sign is free. The fee for all other awards earned by a personal call sign is \$5 (USD), or \$4 (USD) for those 65 or older or disabled. A one-time proof of age or disability is required and will be kept on file by your Area Awards Manager. Your best easily available documentation should be acceptable and you may blank out sensitive information such as driver license numbers or social security numbers. The fee for awards earned by club call signs, special event call signs, or any other non-personal call signs is \$5 (USD) for everyone, no discounts for age or disability. **The fee for endorsements, where applicable, is \$3 (USD).** All replacement certificates, other than to correct printing errors, are \$4 (USD). Charter Members are exempt from the initial fee for the 100-Point Award. The fee for optional plaques varies and must be obtained from the Awards Secretary before applying and paying for an optional plaque.

**Awards fees may be paid by PayPal using a credit card via the Club web site, or by check or money order, subject to details following:**

All may pay awards fees in USD using PayPal via credit card thru the Club Web Site. **All who pay via PayPal must enclose a receipt printed from the PayPal site showing the fees paid along with the award application, QSL cards, (etc) sent to the Area Awards Manager.**

For US stations, any checks or money orders must be made payable to **The 3905 Century Club, Inc** and mailed, **along with a stamped envelope addressed to the Club Treasurer to be used to forward your awards fee** - all this to your Area Awards Manager along with your awards application, QSL cards and any return packaging.

For Canadian and other DX stations, any money orders (no checks) must be in USD and must be made out to your DX Area Awards Manager and sent directly to him along with your awards application, QSL cards and any return packaging.

Fees for multiple awards applied for at the same time as well as fees for plaques that are optional for some awards may be combined in the above check, money order or PayPal award fee payment.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

1. Upon earning the SWL Award, you may wish to work for some or all of the other awards we offer. The same requirement involving a maximum of two confirmations per net session applies to these other awards. You may download any of our awards applications for free from our web site at <http://www.3905ccn.com>, where you will find a lot of useful information about our club. A good place to start would be our **New Member Information** document with information useful to new participants, including a detailed list of the available awards.

If you don't have Internet access and don't know someone who does, you may request individual awards applications and other information by sending a specific request with suitable return postage to our Club Information Officer, Jim Higgins KB3PU, 210 Mallard Drive, Sumter, SC 29150-3181, USA. Email address is info (at) 3905ccn.com. He can also answer your questions about awards or about the Club. Don't send envelopes; he will provide them. All documents are available by mail at a cost of \$0.06 per printed page side plus return postage. Details are in the basic **New Member Information** packet. This **New Member Information** packet requires return US postage to your location for 2 ounces. There is no per page fee for the basic **New Member Information** packet.
