

**THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC.**  
**NATIONAL PARKS AWARD APPLICATION**  
(MIXED NETS)

The National Parks Award is earned for confirmed contacts made with or from National Parks located in the USA, Canada, or other DX entities on any combination of awards nets operated by **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** For more information on US & Canadian National Parks, including a detailed breakdown by location, see <http://www.nps.gov/> , <http://www.pc.gc.ca/> or <http://www.google.com/> .

**REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All applicants for this award must hold a 100-Point Certificate on at least one of the nets from which contacts for this award are submitted.
2. All contacts must be made on **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** awards nets.
3. All contacts must be made **on or after May 1, 2008.**
4. All QSL cards applied toward this award may have been used on prior awards and may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
5. The Park Ranger version of this award is earned for four (4) confirmed contacts made **from** each of ten (10) different national parks – 40 cards required. Each QSL card submitted must indicate that your location was in a specific National Park. Endorsements are available in increments of ten (10) national parks, and for all (currently 101) listed parks, four (4) confirmed contacts made from each.
6. The Tourist version of this award is earned for confirmed contacts made with stations located in twenty (20) different National Parks – 20 cards required. Each QSL card submitted must indicate the contacted call sign was located in a specific National Park. Endorsements are available in increments of ten (10) national parks, and for all (currently 101) listed parks, one confirmed contact per park.

**NOTE:** The difference in the requirements between the initial “Park Ranger” and “Tourist” versions of this award are intended to reflect the relative effort and difficulty involved.

7. You may not use a contact on this award with the same call sign more than once in or from the same National Park.
8. If a listed park restricts operation from the park, either because amateur radio operations are forbidden or because the class of vehicle you are driving is barred from the park, then you may claim to be operating from that park if you are as close as you can get to the park boundary consistent with the safety of yourself and others.
9. Stations operating on a boundary line shared in common by one or more National Parks are considered to be operating from all parks sharing that boundary. You must be as close to that boundary as you can get consistent with park rules and consistent with the safety of yourself and others. The leeway defined in Requirement #8 also applies.
10. All parks other than those prelisted on the application must be verifiable via Internet as true “National Parks.” You are advised to seek verification before making a long trip to an unlisted park. If verification is required, or if questions about the requirements for this award arise, please contact the Awards Committee whose decision will be final.

## SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

1. Complete the application form. Place your QSL cards in the order that you have them listed on the application form. Make sure your correct mailing address is on your application and that all information is complete and legible.
2. To submit your application, enclose your QSL cards **or clear photocopies of same showing all needed info**, the awards fee, a suitably sized **self-addressed** container with adequate postage for return of your QSL cards **if you want them back**, and the completed application form, in a container suitable for the protection of your cards. If you pay by any means other than Paypal, include a stamped envelope addressed to the Club Treasurer for forwarding your payment to the Treasurer. Send all to the Area Awards Manager for the Call Area in which you live. Your QSL cards WILL NOT be returned unless YOU provide the required return postage-paid, **self-addressed** container. Names and addresses for the Awards Managers may be found on the Club website at <http://www.3905ccn.com/officers.htm>.
3. The fee for this award is \$5 (USD), or \$4 (USD) for those 65 or older or disabled. A one-time proof of age or disability is required and will be kept on file. Your best available documentation should be acceptable. There is no fee for endorsements. Any awards fee must be sent by check or money order in US dollars made payable to **The 3905 Century Club, Inc.** You may also pay using Paypal thru the Club Web Site. Fees for multiple awards applied for at the same time as well as fees for plaques that are optional for some awards may be combined in this check, money order or Paypal payment, but do NOT include any other costs in this check or money order.
4. The postage for the return of your QSL cards must be applied to the return container, or enclosed separately. DO NOT combine with the awards fee. A separate check, money order, or postage stamps are acceptable for return postage.
